

## Cultivating Transformative IET’s: A Regional Approach – Region 9

**Description:** Through the support and funding of the Florida Department of Education, Florida IPDAE will be hosting differentiated workshops to each of the 12 adult education regions in the state. These workshops will focus on critical factors for successful IET’s and statewide or regional IET initiatives, applying select components of IPDAE’s IET Playbook and OCTAE’s IET Design Toolkit. The workshop will take existing IET’s, at varying levels of implementation, align them to local/regional data, and create a customized roadmap towards building, revamping, or scaling existing IET’s.
