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




Summarize State Plan and Four Priorities

The vision of Florida's adult education system is to hold learners at the center and deliver outcomes that promote full participation in the workforce, result in high-quality credentials of value and close equity and achievement gaps. The work of transforming Florida's adult education system is now guided by the following strategic priorities:

- <u>Priority 1:</u> Promote regional partnerships to ensure comprehensive approaches that result in **improved learner outcomes**;
- <u>Priority 2:</u> Expand the state's talent pipeline through attainment of credentials of value and acquisition of postsecondary certifications, industryrecognized credentials and degrees;
- Priority 3: Ensure all learners receive high quality instruction that prioritizes
 measurable labor market needs and outcomes while working to eliminate equity
 and achievement gaps in the community; and
- Priority 4: Incent, measure, and support enhanced program effectiveness.

What is a Micro-Credential?

A digital form of micro-certification earned by demonstrating competency in a specific skill via a portfolio of artifacts from classroom practice

Key Components:

- ✓ Description of the skill
- ✓ Requirements for proving competency (artifacts)
- ✓ Performance rubric for each requirement





What is a Micro-Credential?

Micro-Credentials are less like...

- X A College Course... not time based, does not require scope and sequence
- X A PD Workshop... no seat-time, no substitute or travel requirement / expense
- X A Test or Traditional Assessment... not measured by passing an exam


Micro-Credentials are more like...

- ✓ A Driver's License... classroom (drivers ed.)
 → learn by practice in real world, earn by demonstration (performance assessment)
- The Pole Vault... a bar is set; different learning and practice for different needs, end result is clearing the same bar
- A Single-Skill version of familiar portfoliobased education certification... allows practitioners to distinguish themselves as accomplished via their actual practice





What is a Micro-Endorsement?



Micro-Endorsements:


- Are rooted in the research on good practice and represent breadth and depth of demonstrated skill in a given topic
- Consist of multiple individual microcredentials, representing the set of discrete skills needed for certification in a given topic
- Are used by many states as official educator certifications, i.e., replacing Praxis





