



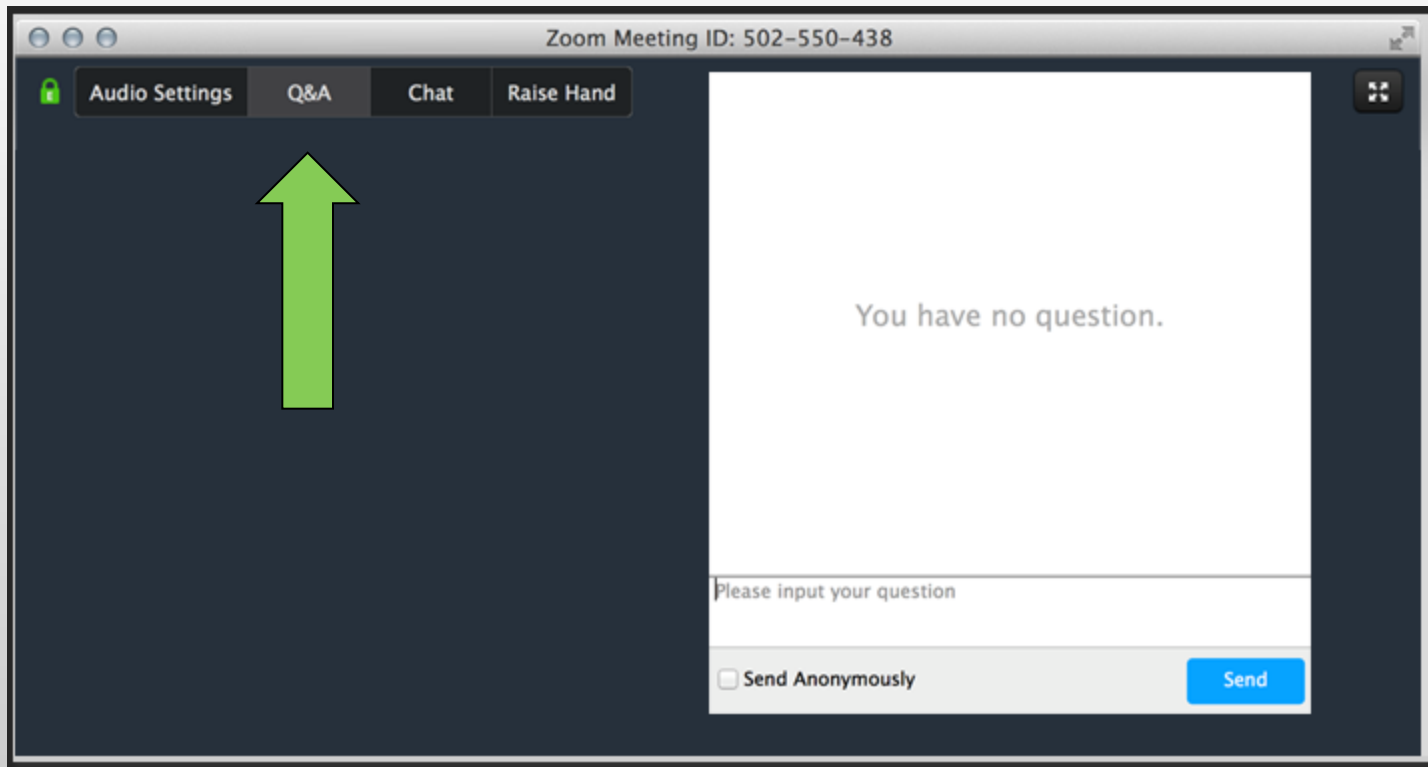

Governor DeSantis charted a new course for Florida to become #1 in the nation for workforce education by 2030.

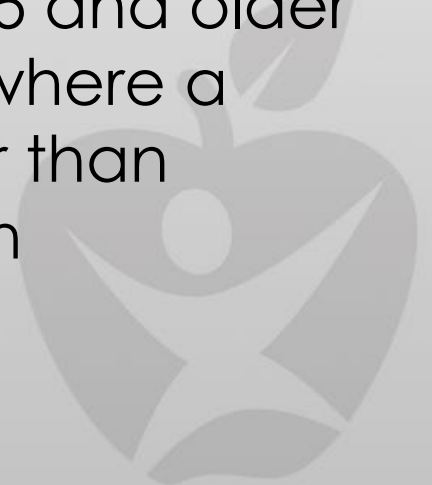




The goal is to increase the percentage of working-age Floridians with a postsecondary certificate, degree, or industry certification to 60% by 2030.



- 11.5% (2,504,829) of Floridians ages 25 and older lack a high school diploma
- 29.4% (6,403,651) of Floridians ages 5 and older live in a home where a language other than English is spoken

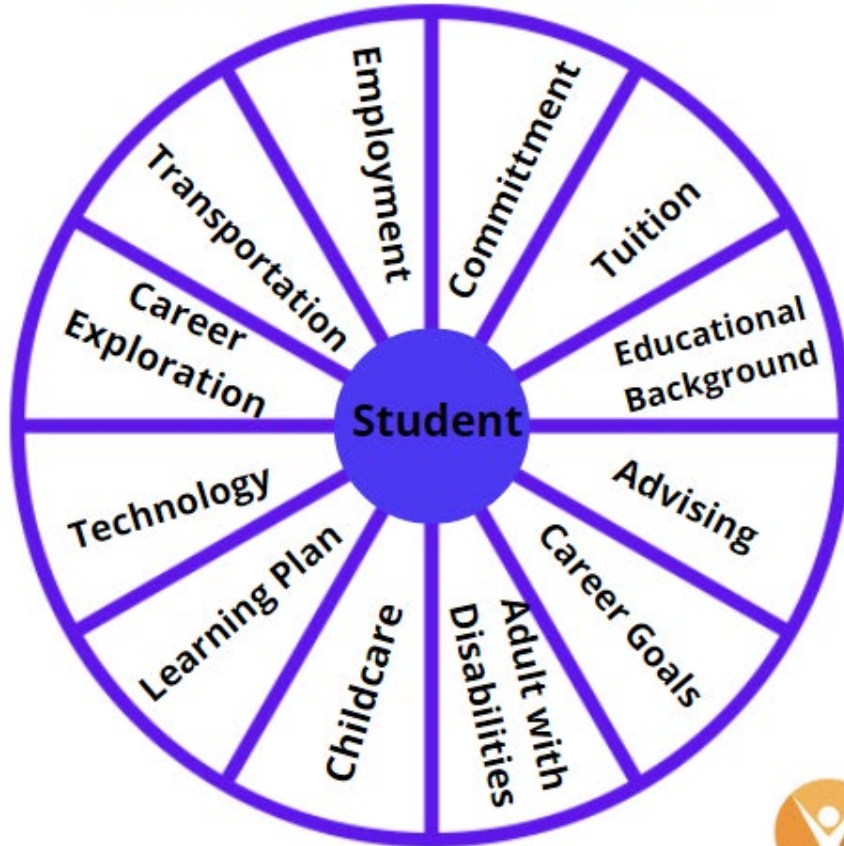

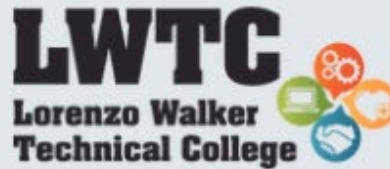

Other Funding Opportunities

Pathways to Career Opportunities Grant

In 2020, LWTC applied for and received funding to implement an HVAC/R pre-apprenticeship program. The targeted population was adult education.

Open Door Grant

In 2021, LWTC applied for and received 1.5 million dollars. Funds were used to implement and deliver IET programs by funding student scholarships.

WDA Vouchers

School Districts and Florida Colleges may waive fees for any fee-nonexempt student. The total value of the fee waivers granted may not exceed the amount established annually in the General Appropriations Act.
