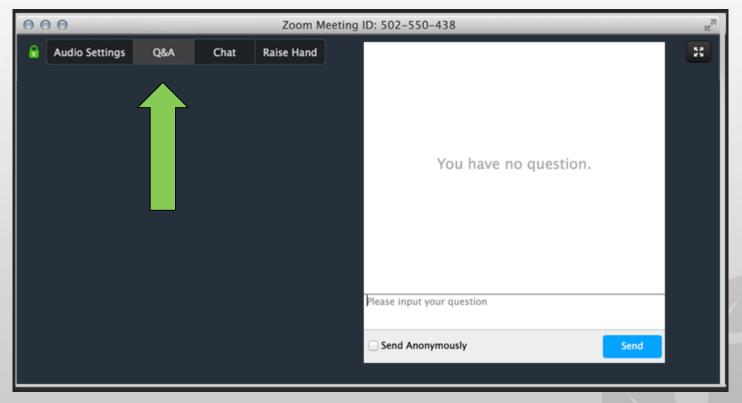

The Early Days!

Partnership with the County Commissioners of Osceola County during the 2020-21 school year.

Students affected by COVID-19 were eligible for upskilling!

Students earned credentials in Microsoft, Medical Assisting, and NCCER.

This project made the transition to the Urban League work a desire to expand these type of classes.



Solving a Problem Through Partnership!

Glen was looking for partnerships that reached parents of young students to earn industry certifications in the evening while their students received instructional services such as STEM instruction.



Problem Solved!

We offered 9 classes during the 2021-22 school year at 4 locations throughout Osceola County.

The partnership has served 225 students.



How it worked!

ALCO recruited the students. Many were enrolled at ALCO. We targeted students who had children in grades 3-5.

The Urban League provided career placement services.

The Urban League paid us when students completed and earned their credentials or completed the program.

The Urban League paid for the cost of the teachers from the children's programming.



Industry Certifications Earned!

The adult students earned a total of 131 certifications this past year. We still have students testing.

Certifications earned in Microsoft and ESB.



Outcomes!

Has made the adjustment to IETs very easy.

Adult Education students want these credentials.

There was evidence that the children were encouraging their parents to come to class.



Future of the Partnership!

We are going to use it to create IETs to lower costs for the Urban League that will concentrate on services for young children of the participants and career services.
