Welcome to IPDAE 2016-17.

This fall, Florida IPDAE will be hosting a statewide GED® Train-the-Trainer Workshop. Developed by GED Testing Service®, this full-day training will provide attendees with workshops that can be presented within their college, school district, correctional facility, or community organization. The purpose of the training is to utilize professional development to build high-performance communities of practice.

The training will focus on the areas of Reasoning through Language Arts and Mathematical Reasoning. These workshops were launched by GEDTS® in July as part of their GEDTS® Professional Development Initiative. Florida is pleased to be able to participate in this project and build training capacity throughout our state.

The full day training will be highly interactive and include activities and resources for the classroom. The training emphasizes skills needed by adult learners as they prepare for the GED® test. Each attendee will receive two, scripted PowerPoint presentations, workbooks, and activities. Attendees will have everything that they need to deliver these two-half day trainings at their worksites.

The GED® Train-the-Trainer will be offered at several locations throughout the state. Plan now to send educators from your organization to one of the sites. Attendees will obtain both the materials for training, as well as valuable activities that they can use in the classroom.

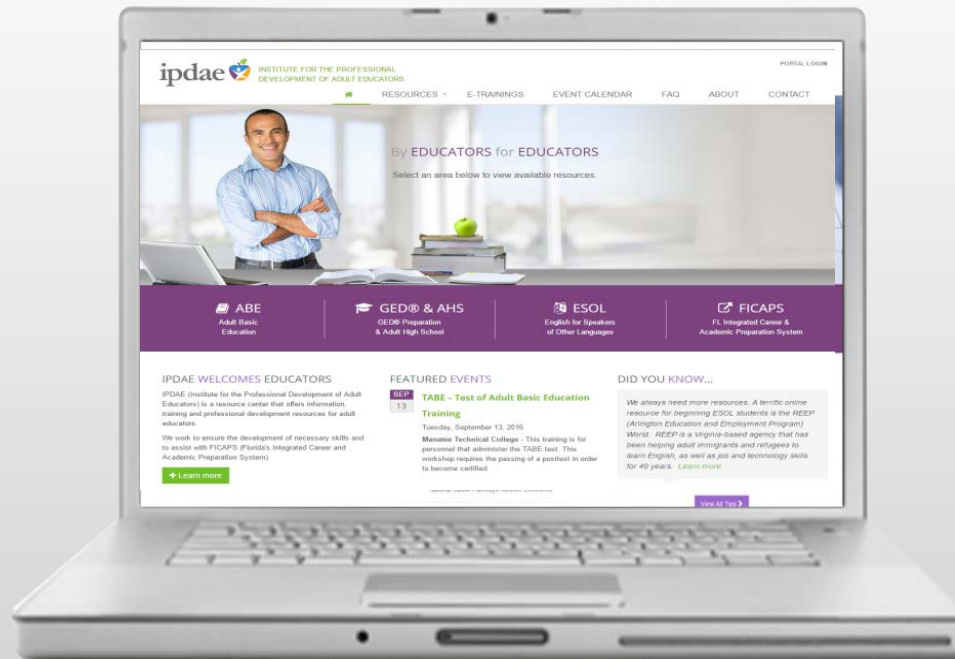
